HFFBC Sunday Health Safety Guidelines *for children/youth/adult teachers are as follows:

Explanation of terms used below:

- "Children" = birth up through grade 5
 - o Nursery ages 0-2
 - o Preschool ages 3-5
 - o Elementary grades 1-5
- "Youth" grade 6-12
 - o Jr. High (grades 6-8)
 - o Sr. High (grades 9-12)

Guidelines:

- a. Upon entering the building, everyone is required to:
 - a. Do hand sanitizing
 - b. Maintain social distancing
 - c. Wear a mask (over two years old)
- b. **Social distance** of 3 feet for children and 6 feet for adults.
- c. **Masks** are required <u>all the time</u> for all Nursery workers, Preschool teachers and Elementary teachers (through grade 2) because social distancing is a problem. An adult may use a face shield, but still must wear a mask with the shield.
 - Adults teaching children/youth from grade 3 & up may remove their masks to teach as long as they are socially distanced.
 - <u>Children</u> (ages 2 and older) are required to wear masks upon *arrival* and *departure*, and when *transitioning* between spaces. They may take masks off when social distanced in the classroom.
- d. **Food/snacks** for Preschool/Nursery may be brought in by parents. They should be packaged and not be shared with other children.
- e. Large group activities in the fellowship hall that are organized and monitored for social distancing and contact may be played. The usual mob play is not allowed. It must be taken outside. It is acceptable to pass balls when socially distanced.
- f. **Cleaning** in the Nursery/Preschool should be done when the class is over. All toys, high touch surfaces, door handles, etc. should be disinfected. If there is six days between use of the area, then it is not much of an issue.
- g. **Pickups** in the Nursery/Preschool from parents will need to be organized by the directors in order to avoid the usual mob of parents at the door. Again, social distancing and masks are required for all adults in the halls and classrooms.
- h. **Entering and exiting must be one way**. This means that the schedule should preclude 'two way traffic.'
- i. Room occupancy will be full at 50%
