Christianity is a faith uniquely rooted in historical events. Unlike almost all other competing worldviews, the Christian faith, from the exodus to the crucifixion, is founded on God’s interactions in human history. The Christian church likewise has developed historically, influenced by and itself influencing the larger cultural horizon. This one semester class will look at the progression of the Christian church, its doctrines, practices, and structures throughout the Patristic, Medieval and Early Modern ages. The goal will be to better understand how we arrived at the current state of the church, its unity, divisions, continuity, and change.
